

BUY A BARROW OF BOULDERS and help to restore the Montgomery Canal

Shropshire Union Canal Society volunteers are working on the Redwith to Prices Bridge stretch of the Montgomery Canal, and are about to start shaping the channel prior to lining. Once the lining is down it needs to have an overburden. It was initially thought that the overburden would be boulders, but it has become apparent that a mix of boulders and concrete blocks is the better option. Boulders will be used wherever they can be seen; concrete blocks will be used elsewhere.



In the present economic climate it is getting harder to find external funding. We don't want to stop work due to lack of funding, so we are asking you to put your hand in your pocket and buy a barrow of boulders — better still, buy a few! This will enable the work to continue unchecked, and you will have the satisfaction of knowing that you have helped in the restoration of a beautiful canal.
