

Arddleen Circular Walk 1

Montgomery Canal

- Full walk 2.3 miles / 3.7 km



A short walk which takes you on a circular route along the towpath of the Montgomery Canal and around small village of Arddleen. Rest for a while at the small community picnic garden by the new wharf in the village and enjoy lovely views across the canal to Criggion and Rodney's Pillar. A county lane takes you southwards out of the village before crossing public footpaths over open fields to re-join the towpath by Burgedin Locks.

Walking Conditions : A fairly level route which follows the canal towpath, roads and open fields. Crossing of step over styles is required. Ground conditions may be wet or muddy underfoot.
