

Arddleen Circular Walk 4

Montgomery Canal

- Full walk 7 miles / 11.2km
- Burgedin shortcut 3 miles / 4.8km
- Varchoel shortcut 4.5 miles / 7.2km



This interesting walk explores the disused Guilsfield Arm of the Montgomery Canal. Originally built to carry lime, slate and lead, this is a short section of canal just over two miles long, part of which is now a nature reserve. Look out for wildlife and historical features such as lime kilns.

Walking Conditions : A fairly level route which follows the canal towpath, roads and open fields. Crossing of step over styles is required. Ground conditions may be wet or muddy underfoot with overgrown vegetation in parts.
